

Animate your Scots poetry recitals with Adobe Express

Why not share Scots poetry using animation? It's easy to animate characters and record audio using <u>Adobe Express</u>, which is available to pupils and staff in Scottish schools via <u>Glow</u>.

Alternatively, anyone can sign up for a <u>free Adobe Creative Cloud account</u>.

Step 1	Choose your Scots poem from the <u>Scots Language Centre</u> or the <u>Scottish poetry library</u> .	Street Talk by J. K. Annand There was a rammie in the street, A stishie and stramash. The crabbit wifie up the stair Pit up her winda sash.
Step 2	Log in to <u>Adobe Express</u> .	Adobe Express
Step 3	Select 'Explore quick actions'. A pop-up will appear.	Explore quick actions
Step 4	Select 'Video' from the menu on the left hand side of the pop-up.	All Social media Video Photo Document Generative Al



Step 5	Select 'Animate characters'.	Animate characters
Step 6	Select your character, background and desired video size (or leave as default).	Animate characters Make an animated character with your own voice. Character Background Size
Step 8	Record your audio (you may need to select an option which allows Adobe to access your device's microphone).	Becord your character's dalogue or biosree MP2, AFF, WAR, and MP4 files 12 minutes and TGB mars per upload Literative
Step 9	Download the video.	Animate characters Download your MP4 or open in Adobe Express to add filters, text, animations, and more. Download Open in editor
