- A contemporary story
- 4 actors maximum
- An interest in the role of music and song in the production style. All writers should have an interest in how music can be integrated into their text. They will be asked to incorporate song lyrics but not write music

The prize for the winning script will be £1500 and the writer will be assisted by a professional dramaturg to bring the script to the point where it is ready for full production.

It is hoped, depending on funding, to tour the winning play in the autumn of 2013. Should this be the case full professional writing rates will be paid on top.
