

INVENT A SCOTS CRAITUR!

A **craitur** is a Scots word meaning 'creature'. The **Shellycoat** gets his name from his robe or **goon** of shells. Can you invent another **craitur** who wears a different kind of **goon**?

Try to use at least one **Scots word** in your invented name. For example:

- ☆ a **craitur** with a robe of prickly thistles might be called a **Jaggycoat** or **Thrisselgoon**.
- ☆ a **craitur** with a robe of snowflakes or frost might be a **Snawycot** or **Frostygoon**.

Here are some **Scots words** you could use, but you can also use other words that you know.

- ☆ Its **goon** could be made of: **brambles**, **ice-shoggles** (=icicles), **strae** (=straw)
- ☆ It could be: **claggy** (=sticky), **clarty** (=dirty), **taigelt** (=tangled), **tousie** (=shaggy)
- ☆ It could: **birl** (whirl), **brattle** (=rattle), **glent** (=gleam), **shoogle** (shake)

You could also add the word **goon** to the end of an adjective like **mossy** or **twiggy** to make **Mossygoon** or **Twiggygoon**.
