- 5. Poems must be unpublished and not accepted for publication elsewhere.
- 6. Poems should be no longer than 36 lines including verse breaks.
- 7. Poems may be written in any form but must be the original work of the entrant.
- 8. Poets name, address, email and telephone number on every poem.
- 9. Poets should retain copies of their work as entries will not be returned.
- 10. Poems for the anthology will be selected by representatives of Francis Boutle and Poetry Cornwall their decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
